Important

\$50 registration fee will hold your spot and will credit to the total due. **Registration fee is not refundable. Full payment must be paid by Feb 1.**

Refunds will be given as follows: (minus \$50 registration)

100% refund- time of payment through Dec. 1, 2021

50% refund- December 2- Jan 31, 2022

No refunds after Feb 1, 2022, though you may "sell" any fees you have paid to someone who hasn't already paid their registration.

Move in and set up after 4pm on Monday followed by social time and dinner. Class is 8:30-5 Tuesday, 9-5 Wednesday, and 9-12 on Thursday. Hours beyond class time may be spent at your loom, but there won't be an instructor available. Students have been known to weave late in the evening or get up early to work on their project.

You are required to bring your own towels, pillows and bedding.
